

Cosmetology Instructor Training

1000 Hour

Course Description:

The State of Illinois requires Cosmetologists wishing to obtain the Instructor license to take 1000 hours of training, if they do not have a least two years' experience, which takes approximately nine (9) months to complete on a full-time schedule. The course is designed to teach the methods and principles of teaching. Upon completion students will be prepared to take the State Board Exam to acquire the Instructor license. Instructor program starts are considered case-by-case

Admission Requirements

Cosmetology Instructor Student 1000 hour

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must have obtained a high school diploma or GED certificate
- Copy of driver's license or state ID
- Copy of high school diploma or GED certificate
- Copy of your Social Security card
- An essay stating why you would like to join the program and pursue a career in this industry and where you see yourself in 5 years
- High school transcripts
- College transcripts (if applicable)
- Two professional letters of recommendation.
